#### **Decision Making**

A quick introduction to what consensus decision making looks like and how it can be useful for community groups to make decisions.

- Biodiversity/gardens/rewilding

What are some research questions that we could look at on these (one suggestion was about rewilding gardens)?

Need to consider:

- Time and resources available
- Maximising impact
- Clear and achievable project

- surveys/questionnaires
- interviews
- focus groups
- desk research?
- Quantitative techniques e.g. collection of numerical data

Introduction to Doughnut Economics

- A framework for community-led research?
- Currently used by Climate Action Leeds and Otley 2030 as a tool to paint a portrait of where we currently stand
- Could it be used at a community level to make decisions?
